## The Problem

- **\$2.3B/year federal Deaf (ASL) interpreter spend.**
- **67% of requests unmet due to interpreter shortage.**
- Captions & subtitles do not suffice because 80% of Deaf Adults do not read English fluently.
- American Sign Language (ASL) is the primary language of Deaf, not written English.
- Demand structurally exceeds human supply—**an unsolvable problem with interpreters alone.**

## The Solution

- **Secure, real-time AI ASL interpreter.**
- **Real-time ASL <> voice** translation eliminates delays & shortages.
- **Photorealistic AI avatar** enables natural, two-way communication.
- Compliant deployment for enterprise, regulated, and classified environments.
- Native integrations with **Zoom, Teams, Google, WebEx.**

## Traction and Validation

- Active engagement with federal & commercial stakeholders.
- Already backed by pre-seed capital.
- Two active pilots deployed.
- \$500K ARR in pipeline (e.g., SeaWorld Orlando, Yale University Museum).
